

## PARENT / ATHLETE INFORMATION – 2022-2023

Virginia Beach High School Water Polo League (including the Kraken Youth Travel Team) is a member of USA Water Polo. In addition to SafeSport regulations, USAWP has recently mandated the institution of a minor-athlete safety program, referred to as a BASS (BOKRIM Abuse Safety System). The BASS document is available to view upon request. In accordance with these new requirements, please note the following required disclosures and notes:

2. All Adults participating with the VBHSWPL (including **Athletes who are 18 years old** at any point during the season and/or Volunteers who may have regular contact with minor athletes) must review and sign our Adult Behavior Requirements and Expectations and take the required SafeSport training. Electronic acknowledgement of the Adult Behavior Requirements and Expectations can be provided via Google Form and is listed on the Safety page of our website (see #1 for website link or follow Google form link directly: <https://forms.gle/5DzJmEn4bVGhyvWY6>).
3. We encourage all parents/guardians to take the free SafeSport training for parents. We also encourage all parents/guardians to consider the free age-appropriate training for their minor athletes. 4. All VBHSWPL representatives, and many of our adult guests are mandatory reporters. They are required to notify Law Enforcement or Child Protective Services, and the US Center for SafeSport as soon as they develop reasonable suspicion that SAM may have, may be, or may be in danger of happening to a minor or vulnerable adult. Even if you are not a mandatory reporter, any athlete safety concerns, including sexual abuse or misconduct concerns, should be reported to:

5. Any mention of additional opportunities to play water polo outside of the VBHSWPL/Kraken team is informational only. This includes the local Master's Team (Hampton Roads Water Polo). VBHSWPL is not affiliated with this organization and our policies do not apply to that group or their activities. Any participation in these activities is at your discretion. Additionally, please note that the Masters team is associated with American Water Polo, not USA Water Polo.
6. All communications (in-person or electronic) with Athletes will be in the presence of another Adult (either a VBHSWPL representative, and/or a parent/guardian).
  - a. One-to-one in-person interactions are prohibited, always and everywhere, unless the interaction is easily observable and at a distance from at least one other adult (VBHSWPL representative or parent/guardian) such that the interaction is easily interruptible by the other adult.
  - b. Coaches will be utilizing group messaging for the team which will include, at minimum, another VBHSWPL adult representative on the communication. Parents/guardians are welcome and encouraged to join the messaging group.

- c. If an Athlete needs to message a coach privately for any reason, they must cc their parent/guardian. In the event an Athlete forgets to cc their parent/guardian, the coach's reply will cc the parent/guardian with a reminder to please include them on future messages.
7. [Fall League] As a Club Sport, travel to/from the practices and games is the responsibility of the athletes and their parents/guardians. Coaches are not able to provide transportation for athletes. If your athlete carpool with other athletes and/or families, it is at the discretion of the parents/guardians.
8. [Fall League] Activities at the Virginia Beach Recreation Centers are held during operating hours at a facility which is open to the members of the Recreation Centers, including the locker rooms. For this reason, athletes will be asked to use the buddy system in the locker rooms at all times, or use the single-use changing rooms, or change at home.
9. [Kraken Travel Team] Travel to/from the practices and games is the responsibility of the athletes and their parents/guardians. If your athlete carpool with other athletes and/or families, or coaches, it is at the discretion of the parents/guardians and all parties should follow the Adult Behavior guidelines. Exceptions to the guidelines are limited and require written consent from parent/guardian on an annual (calendar year) basis.
10. If there are any persons with whom the Athlete is not permitted to leave from the VBHSWPL activities, the parent/guardians must provide written documentation to the VBHSWPL.
